Entry Submission: Please return all completed entries and fees to the Downtown Moses Lake Association at P.O. Box 1201, Moses Lake, WA 98837 by November 27, 2024. Alternatively, you can scan and email your application to events@downtownmoseslake.org. If payment has not yet been made, please mail a check to the above P.O. Box or submit it in person (or our mailbox) at 205 S Division Street.

<u>Assembly Point:</u> The parade assembly can begin at 3:30pm. If you need to set up earlier please contact the DMLA Event Coordinator at 509-986-7478. Please see additional detailed info in "Parade Info and Directions" below.

<u>Judging:</u> Judging will take place prior to the start of the parade from 5pm-6:30pm, you must be in the lineup by 6pm to qualify for an award. Award winners will be notified after the event.

Judging Criteria:

All Entries: Presentation (Originality, Design, Color, Costumes, Decorations), Theme, and Effort

<u>Parade Route:</u> We have a brand new parade route for this year. It is the same style as the years in the past, but we have extended it by one block. This includes the staging area so please make note of the new maps in the Parade Route section.

Rules:

- o No entries conveying controversial/irreverent messages and/or political statements will be allowed to participate in the parade.
- o The parade organizers reserve the right to reject any entry not in compliance with the rules or theme of the Holiday parade. Further, any entry in violation of these rules or operated in an unsafe/dangerous manner will be removed from the parade.
- o All equestrian entries MUST have a clean-up crew on the parade route.

IMPORTANT: Should be able to read in 15 seconds or less! What you write here will be what the emcee reads during the parade as you pass through Sinkiuse square.

- 1. **Insurance:** A Certificate of Insurance is required, naming the Downtown Moses Lake Association and the City of Moses Lake as additional insured. (Cars must furnish proof of automobile insurance.) Email your proof of insurance to events@downtownmoseslake.org with your organization's name and contact info.
- 2. **Entry Fees:** All entries are required to pay an entry fee the day of application by mailing in the application and payment to PO Box 1201 in Moses Lake or in person or mailbox at 205 S Division Street.

IMPORTANT NOTICE- Brand NEW Parade Route and Staging area

Thank you for participating in the Agricultural Appreciation Parade!

Float/Vehicle Arrival: Parade lineup starts at 3:30pm. Please see the new check in/registration location on the new map below.



Parade line up is new for this year and is going to be staged on Dogwood Street. *Please do not arrive at the Surf N Slide parking lot as registration will no longer be there.* To get to your staging location, please enter through A Street to get to the registration booth and your staging location will be assigned.

Please find our DMLA booth for registration. At check in you will receive your number. Place it on the passenger side near the front of the vehicle (on door or window).

Once you are in your row for the parade you may leave your vehicle and enjoy the street party on 3rd. Parade will start at 7pm. Please be in your vehicle or in the lineup by no later than 6:45pm ready to go.

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Restrooms: There will be a port-a-potty at registration and bathrooms at Sinkiuse Square near the Post Office on 3rd.

NEW Parade Route:



Follow the entry in front of you or the map below for the approx. 1-mile parade route.

Non-Parade Vehicle Parking:

Please park vehicles for those involved in your parade entry as furthest from the lineup area as possible to avoid issues with space for our parade lineup and for safety. Parking lots highlighted in yellow are for parade entry participants only. The purple highlighted area is for public parking.

Judging:

Judging will begin to take place prior to the parade starting from 5pm-6:30pm and when you get to the clock at 3rd & Ash. You will pause for judging for about 20 seconds or as long as it takes our emcee to introduce you. Some announcements may be shortened due to timing and we will try our best to announce everyone. We will try to keep the flow steady with the cold weather in mind.

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If you are a winner of an award, you will be contacted. We will arrange a time to have you pick up your award.

Saturday Morning Cleanup:

After events like these we ask you to come back and help out the next morning to pick up the food and candy wrappers left behind.

If you're able to help out with picking up the litter, please meet us at the Obra Project at 205 S Division Street at 9AM the following morning. We will supply garbage bags.
